How the challenge works

We read **two chapters per week**:

- **Chapter 1:** Monday–Thursday
- **Chapter 2:** Thursday–Sunday

You read *on your own* – whenever it fits your schedule – but each time you finish a chapter, please let us know in the group. This little check-in helps everyone stay motivated (yes, that includes me too!).

First Week

You have time **until September 4** to join one of the groups **AND** introduce yourself. If you fail to introduce yourself, you will be removed from the group. This ensures that we get to know each other a little and that only motivated people participate. So this introduction is your first activity and we will start with chapter 1 on September 4.



What you can do in the groups

This challenge is not just about reading – it’s also a chance to speak and write! Here are a few ways to participate (voice messages are welcome!):

1. **Read the chapter out loud** – or a part of it.
2. **Summarize the chapter** in your own words.
3. **Share your opinion** about what happened.
4. **Answer the comprehension questions** orally.
5. **Use the “Language Tips” expressions** in sentences of your own.
6. **Ask each questions** about each chapter’s content.

A few important notes

This is a self-directed challenge. That means: **You are in charge of your learning.** I’ll be there, listening and cheering you on, but I won’t correct your grammar or pronunciation – unless I hear something that’s really unclear and worth explaining for everyone.

If you’re unsure about a grammar point or a word, feel free to ask – but please try to look it up first. Learning to find your own answers is part of the journey 😊.
